The Academic Forum Leaders



Professor Helen Spencer-Oatey

Helen Spencer-Oatey is a Professor in the Centre for Applied Linguistics at the University of Warwick. She has lived and worked in Asia for more than 10 years and travels regularly to Asia, particularly China. Her primary research interests are intercultural adaptation, the internationalisation of higher education and intercultural interaction/pragmatics. She's published articles in top journals and well-known books that have been re-published in China, (e.g. Intercultural Interaction, with Peter Franklin).



Dr Daniel Dauber

Dr Daniel Dauber is an Associate Professor in the Centre for Applied Linguistics at the University of Warwick. His major research interests include organisational culture and change, as well as understanding individual behaviour in intercultural contexts from a multi-disciplinary perspective. He is currently analysing the student and staff experiences of 16 internationalising universities in Europe, using the Global Education Profiler (GEP), a tool he co-developed with Professor Helen Spencer-Oatey.


